## Choral/Vocal Music

### **Chancel Choir**

The Chancel Choir is the primary choir of the church. The choir sings about three times a month for worship and for major festivals of the church year. This group of 25-30 members is directed by Rob Meyer and is open to anyone confirmation age and older. One only needs a love of singing to participate, all the rest is provided in rehearsals. In Joyful Noise we sing a variety of music and include drums, chimes and other instruments frequently to teach music reading skills along with proper vocal technique.
